SUBJECT: Policy Letter #9, APFT Incentives

1. References.

a. FM 21-20 PHYSICAL FITNESS TRAINING

2. For all Soldiers in 504th BDE SIG Co, the following incentives will be offered for the following accomplishments on the Army Physical Fitness Test:

- a. Score 90 in each event on a record APFT – Battalion Commander Certificate of Achievement and 3 Day Pass.
- b. Score over a 290 on the record APFT – In addition to all the incentives earned by achieving 90 in each event, you can also PT on your own for 60 days with the exception of Sergeants Time Training PT and company level runs or ruck marches, and then you will have to retake the APFT to maintain the PT on your own privileges.
- c. Score a 300 on the record APFT – In addition to the incentives listed above, an additional 4 Day Pass and a BN Coin.
- d. Improve your APFT Score by 30 points on your record APFT - Battalion Commander Certificate of Achievement and 3 Day Pass.
- e. For those Soldiers who have a permanent profile that dictates that an alternate event for an exercise that can only achieve a maximum of 60 points for that event, for the other events that are not an alternate event, if you achieve 90 in each event, you will still qualify for the Battalion Commander Certificate of Achievement and 3 Day Pass. If you max both events, you can qualify for the remainder of the incentives.

3. The max number of times you can earn these achievements, with the exception of the BN Coin and Battalion Commander Certificate of Achievement, is twice a calendar year as it is required that you are required to take a PT test every 6 months.

4. The max number times you can earn the BN Coin or Battalion Commander Certificate of Achievement is once a calendar year.

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5. Soldiers who intentionally decrease their current PT score in order to qualify for the “increase your APFT score by 30 points incentive” will not qualify for the incentive. If your APFT score decreases from your previous score, the 30 points incentive will be based off of your previous or higher score on file.
6. Soldiers who increase their score by 30 points and also achieve 90 points in each event on the same record APFT will not qualify for 2 Battalion Commander Certificate of Achievements but may qualify for the other incentives.
7. This policy is effective immediately.



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
