

Colonel Brian R. Bisacre

Colonel Brian Bisacre is a native of Wakefield, Massachusetts. He was commissioned as a Military Police Second Lieutenant upon graduation from Norwich University in 1989. After graduating from the Military Police Officer Basic Course, COL Bisacre was assigned to Schofield Barracks, Hawaii where he served as a platoon leader for the 58th Military Police Company, Battalion S-4 Officer, 25th Military Police Battalion and Aide de Camp to the Assistant Division Commander, 25th Infantry Division.

Following the Military Police Officer Advanced Course in 1994, he was assigned to Fort Bragg, NC where he served as the Plans Officer for the 16th Military Police Brigade (Airborne) and as Commander of the 82nd Military Police Company, 82nd Airborne Division.

Following his assignments at Fort Bragg, COL Bisacre served at the United States Military Academy, West Point NY as an instructor in the Department of Military Instruction. His last year at West Point, he served as the West Point Installation Deputy Provost Marshal. Following his assignment at the Military Academy, he attended the Naval Command and Staff College at the Naval War College, Newport, RI.

Following Command and Staff College, COL Bisacre was assigned to the 8th Military Police Brigade in Korea. While in Korea, he served as the S-3 and XO of the 728th Military Police Battalion, S-3 for the 8th Military Police Brigade and Deputy Brigade Commander of the 8th Military Police Brigade.

Following his assignment as Deputy Brigade Commander, COL Bisacre took command of the 728th Military Police Battalion in June of 2007 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii. In November of 2007, LTC Bisacre deployed the battalion in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and assumed responsibility of Task Force Warfighter in support of 1st Armor Division, Task Force Iron, Multi National Division-North in Tikrit, Iraq. In June of 2009, COL Bisacre changed command of the 728th Military Police Battalion and was assigned to NORAD and USNORTHCOM in Colorado Springs, CO as the Command Security Director and later as the J34, Force Protection and Anti Terrorism Division. COL Bisacre assumed command of the 18th Military Police Brigade, Sembach, Germany on 15 July 2011.

COL Bisacre holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice from Norwich University, a Masters degree in Education from Troy State University and a Masters degree in Strategic Studies from the Naval War College. He is a graduate of the Military Police Basic and Advanced Course and the Naval Command and Staff College. His awards and decorations include the Bronze Start Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leave clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with four oak leave clusters, the Army Achievement medal, Air Assault Badge, Master Jumpmaster Badge and the Combat Action Badge.
