Mr. Tom Nunn became the Deputy Chief of Staff at the 21st Theater Command in April, 2015. He began his career as a Department of the Army Civilian in May 2003 following a 30 year active duty career. Prior to his current position, Nunn served as the Kwajalein Integrator for HQ Installation Management Command (IMCOM), Ft. Sam Houston, Texas, responsible for planning, directing, managing and coordinating all activities supporting the transfer of USAG-Kwajalein Atoll and all associated resources from Strategic Missile Defense Command (SMDC) to IMCOM.

From October 2009 to October 2014, he served as a Region Installation Support Team Chief and Specialist in Central Region, IMCOM. Prior to this, he served as the Deputy to the Garrison Commander and Supervisory Plans and Operations Specialist, DPTMS at USAG Schinnen, the Netherlands.

Nunn served on active duty from June 1973 until June 2003. He served in a variety of command and staff positions including four assignments over nine years at the 21st TSC. The highlights of his career were commander, 51st Maintenance Battalion, 21st TSC, Mannheim, Germany from 1991-1993, and commander, AFNORTH Support Group (NATO), Brunssum, the Netherlands from 2000-2003.

He also served as the G-3, 21st TSC, Kaiserslautern Germany from 1998-2000 where he was responsible for the transformation of the 21stst TAACOM to the 21st Theater Support Command (TSC), to include establishment of a G-Staff structure.

His education includes a Bachelor of Science Degree from the United States Military Academy, West Point, NY and a Master of Engineering Degree in Automotive Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Troy, New York. Additionally, he has a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Policy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, Ft. McNair, Washington, DC.

Mr. Nunn's awards include the Defense Superior Service Medal and Legion of Merit.
