Klaus Krapf started his career in 1977 and served over four years in the German Air Force, as a 1st Airplane Mechanic

Krapf successfully completed the Mechanical Technician Master Degree by the Handwerkskammer (Chamber of Trade) for Oberbayern in 1982. In 1983, he began working for the U.S. Army as an optical instrument mechanic with the former Equipment Support Activity (ESA), 7th Army Training Command (7th ATC).

Krapf was promoted to Small Arms Inspector in 1986. In 1992, he was selected to run the Army Oil Analyzing Program (AOAP), Test Measurement and Diagnostic Equipment (TMDE) and Warranty Program for the 7th ATC. In 1996, he became the senior foreman of the ESA

Following the transfer of the ESA from the 7th ATC to the 21st Theater Support Command (now 21st Theater Sustainment Command), Krapf was promoted to Facility Manager of Maintenance Activity Vilseck.
