Command Sergeant Major Thomas Moore is the Command Sergeant Major for Special Troops Battalion, 16th Sustainment Brigade, in Baumholder, Germany.

Moore holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Maryland in Management Studies and a Master of Science degree in Human Resource Management and Organizational Leadership from Chapman University in Orange, Calif. Additionally, he is recognized as a Master Logistician from the International Society of Logistics.

Moore entered the U.S. Army in 1985 as an Equipment Records and Parts Specialist. His previous assignments include: Supply Sergeant and Platoon Sergeant, G Troop, 2nd Squadron, 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment; Logistic and Maintenance Evaluator, Fort Bliss, Texas; BN S4, 3rd Squadron, 6th Cavalry, Korea; BN S4, 302nd Military Intelligence BN, Germany; First Sergeant, HHC 3/158th Aviation BN, Germany; Brigade S4, 12th Combat Aviation Brigade, Germany; Senior Operations Sergeant Major, 593rd Sustainment Brigade, Fort Lewis, Washington; Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Assistant Chief of Staff for Logistics for NETCOM (A) Fort Huachuca, Arizona; and Command Sergeant Major for Special Troops Battalion, 1st Sustainment Brigade Fort Riley, Kansas. Command Sgt. Maj.
