212th Combat Support Hospital

Background

The 212th Combat Support Hospital consists of a Role III/Nato Role Iie medical care facility and 2 Forward Surgical Teams. Transitioning from the U.S. Army's last remaining MASH to the current CSH setup is the only forward deployed Combat Support Hospital in the USAREUR footprint. Their mission, which is to provide hospitalization and outpatient services to the American Soldier as well as our multinational Allies and Partners, firmly places them in the Strong Europe campaign.

The Soldiers of the 212th CSH have a distinguished history of selfless service to fellow Soldiers and to our nation, saving thousands of lives on countless battlefields. The 212th CSH is the most decorated tactical hospital in the Active Army. Assigned to the 30th Medical Command in support of USAREUR, they have earned their motto. "Skilled and Resolute".

The headquarters is located in Miesau, Germany at the Miesau Army Depot..

Deployment Support

Soldiers from the 212th CSH constantly maintain a deployment readiness posture. The CSH can deploy a Modified Early Entry Package (MEEP) that can self-sustain for 72 hours waiting for the rest of the hospital. The hospital is scalable from 44 beds to 84 beds, depending on their requirements. Soldiers from the Forward Surgical Teams are deployable within 18 hours of notification with Role II capabilities. The 212th CSH is postured to globally deploy a capable and ready medical force anywhere in support of the 30th Medical Brigade mission from Unified Land Operations to Global Health Engagements, strengthening alliances and building partner capability and capacity.
