Belgian Military Fitness Badge Competition

MISSION: To conduct a bilateral physical training event, contributing to increased confidence in military interoperability with our Allies.

WHO: 212th CSH; OIC CPT Jed Leifson

WHAT: Belgian Military Fitness Badge competition

WHERE: Miesau, Germany

WHEN: 24 September 2014

WHY: To promote physical readiness and resilience through international sports competitions with our allied training partners.

EVENTSUMMARY: On 24 Sep 2014, the 212th CSH conducted a Belgian Military Fitness Badge with the oversight of CMsgt Van Ryzeghem from the Belgian Army. Forty-four total Soldiers attempted to attain one of three award levels for the combined test. Events included one minute of sit-ups, one minute of push-ups and a 2400 meter run. The events were weighted to achieve the final combined score. A total of 33 Soldiers passed the minimum standards and will be receiving a basic badge. Of those 33, four earned GOLD, 19 earned SILVER and 10 earned BRONZE for their efforts. Twenty-seven of the 33 obtained maximum scores for PU and SU, including all females. This achievement is authorized to be added to Soldiers' official military records.
