Grafenwöhr Training Area training advisory for November 16-22, 2015

GRAFENWÖHR, Germany (Nov. 12, 2015) – This is an informational advisory for the communities around the Grafenwöhr Training Area. Times and locations of activities in this announcement may change due to weather conditions or as determined necessary by Grafenwoehr Range Operations division. Nov. 18-20: A multinational Combined Arms Live Fire Training exercise (CALFEX) will take place on Grafenwoehr Training Area. The live fire training is the culminating exercise in support of exercise Combined Resolve V and will include tanks, rotary wing aircraft, and artillery.

Nov. 22: German National Day of Mourning: No firing is permitted

According to the SOFA agreement, Grafenwöhr Training Area operates range operations from 0800 to 2300 in the month of November using munitions of 20mm and larger, and 24 hours daily using munitions smaller than 20mm.

We schedule the majority of our training events during weekdays and normal work day hours.
