Grafenwöhr Training Area training advisory for May 16-22, 2016

GRAFENWÖHR, Germany (May 12, 2016) – This is an informational advisory for the communities around the Grafenwöhr Training Area. Times and locations of activities in this announcement may change due to weather conditions or as determined necessary by Grafenwoehr Range Operations division. This release is not all inclusive, it is meant to provide information about training activities and potential noise generating events for the local population.

Exercise Combined Resolve VI is a Joint Multinational Training Command, U.S. Army directed exercise held at the Grafenwoehr and Hohenfels Training Areas. Combined Resolve VI will include about 500 participants from 5 nations.
