Grafenwöhr Training Area training advisory for September 26-October 2, 2016

GRAFENWÖHR, Germany (Sept. 23, 2016) – This is an informational advisory for the communities around the Grafenwöhr Training Area. Times and locations of activities in this announcement may change due to weather conditions or as determined necessary by Grafenwoehr Range Operations division. This release is not all-inclusive. It is meant to provide information about training activities and potential noise-generating events for the local population.

The Bundeswehr is conducting a Combined Arms Live-Fire Exercise (CALFEX) September 22-30. The CALFEX includes mortar, artillery and aviation forces. The aviation mission is scheduled to take place September 26-28. There may be an increase in aircraft noise on these days.

Helicopter Door Gunnery Training is also scheduled on September 29-30.

According to the Status of Forces Agreement, Grafenwöhr Training Area operates range operations from 0800 to 2400 in the months of September and October using munitions of 20mm and larger, and 24 hours daily using munitions smaller than 20mm.

The 7th Army Training Command is conscious of the impact that training activities have on the local community. We strive to be good members of the community. We schedule the majority of our training events during weekdays and normal work day hours.
