GTA uses the unified resources of the 7ATC, particularly simulations, to expand the training battlespace by blending live, virtual and constructive elements.

Digitally-linked GTA ranges can be connected to exercises throughout Europe to enhance command and control and provide more realistic training.

JOINT & COMBINED TRAINING



GTA features joint and combined training in the air and on the ground. GTA facilities offer ideal locations to build tactical interoperability.

ROTATIONAL TRAINING



GTA serves as the homestation in Europe for many of the Army's rotational forces in support of U.S. European Command and Operation Atlantic Resolve.

OUR MISSION



Located in Grafenwöhr, Germany, the GTA is the U.S. Army's largest and most sophisticated permanent training area in Europe. We support all levels of live-fire training, from small arms to artillery, tanks to fixed-wing aircraft.




Range 309 Shoothouse
This live-fire facility includes 10 reconfigurable rooms, 3 hallways, an overhead catwalk with cameras and an enhanced after-action review suite.



Range 118
A fully-instrumented live-fire range including 26 thermal cameras, fiber-linked targets and tracking, 2 replicated villages and an on-site after-action review theater. Easily connected to adjacent ranges to expand training reach.

Bunker Drop Zone
Largest of GTA's 3 airborne training drop zones. Supports personnel and equipment drops. Easily accessed from Grafenwöhr Army Airfield via U.S. Air Force C-130s.

A realistic, 360° live-fire combat outpost featuring a trench complex, village structures, mortar firing points and more than 150 vehicle and personnel targets.



Bleidorn Tower
Highest point on GTA. Ideal for joint training with U.S. Air Force and NATO close air support assets.
