We've been developing noncommissioned officers in Europe for more than 65 years, making us the oldest NCO Academy in the U.S. Army.



The 7th Army NCO Academy was established in 1949 in Munich (Jensen Barracks). Thousands of Soldiers serving in Europe during the Cold War passed through the gates of the Academy.

In 1990, the Academy moved to the Grafenwöhr Training Area, where it could take advantage of the resources of the 7th Army Training Command. In 2005, the Academy moved to its present facilities on Grafenwöhr's Camp Normandy.



During our long and distinguished history, we've welcomed and trained more international military students than all other U.S. Army NCO academies combined. Our graduates have, and will continue, to form the core of a STRONG EUROPE.

OUR MISSION

The 7th Army NCO Academy trains U.S., Allied and Partner Nation Soldiers to the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy curriculum and fosters a conducive learning environment where leaders are held accountable for their actions, both on and off duty.



Located in Grafenwöhr, Germany, the 7th Army NCOA is the oldest and largest NCO Academy in the U.S. Army. We train future leaders to be disciplined and embody the Army Values required to successfully lead at the team and squad levels.

7th Army NCO Academy: Leaders training leaders

The foundation of our academy is the Army's Basic Leader Course, a 22-day residence program which includes 3 modules and 169 academic hours. The course is designed to provide junior enlisted Soldiers with the tools and skills to become team and squad leaders in the U.S. Army.

LEADERSHIP MODULE



An academic introduction to basic Army leadership, including the history, culture, roles and responsibilities of the NCO Corps.

TRAINING MODULE



Focused on teaching junior leaders how to train and manage Soldiers and ensure their team's professional and personal readiness.


WAR-FIGHTING MODULE



Hands-on instruction in small-unit combat tactics, techniques and procedures. Culminates in a 36-hour intensive situation training exercise.
