Col. David Pendall was commissioned in 1990 through the Ohio University Army ROTC Program and holds a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Ohio University, a Master of Science in Administration from Central Michigan University (CMU), a Master in Military Art and Science in Theater Operations from the Army Command and General Staff College/Advanced Military Studies Program, and a Graduate Certificate in Information Systems Management from CMU. He was also an Army War College Fellow at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's (MIT) Security Studies Program (2012-2013).

Previous assignments include service with the 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment in Fulda, Germany; Battalion and Brigade Combat Team S2 positions within the 1st Cavalry Division (1st CD); Company Commander, A/312 MI BN (Operation Joint Forge), MND-N (1st CD); Battalion S3, 741st MI Battalion; Strategic Planner, National Security Agency, SIGINT Directorate; J5 Planner, CENTCOM Forward; Intelligence Planner and Analysis and Control Element (ACE) Chief, MNC-I; U.S. Army Europe (USAREUR) ACE Chief, 24th MI Battalion/66th MI Brigade; Chief, USAREUR ISR Plans Chief, Intel Plans Officer; NATO/ISAF Joint Command HQ; CJ2 (Senior Intelligence Officer), Regional Command-East, concurrently serving as the G2, 1st CD; and the Department of the Army G2 Liaison Officer with MIT Lincoln Laboratory.

His deployments include Bosnia-Herzegovina, Qatar, Iraq, Turkey, and Afghanistan. His most recent assignment was Commander, 66th Military Intelligence Brigade.

He is a graduate of the Military Intelligence Officer's Basic Course, Military Intelligence Officer's Advanced Course, U.S. Army's Command and General Staff College, the Army's School of Advanced Military Studies (SAMS), and the Army War College's Defense Strategy Course, and the Joint Staff College.
