Sgt. Maj. Jeffrey L. Campbell is the senior enlisted advisor to U.S. Army Europe's Deputy Chief of Staff, G-4. Campbell is the seventeenth sergeant major selected to serve in this position beginning Jan. 1, 2016.

Campbell enlisted in the Army Aug. 5, 1992, and conducted basic training and advanced individual training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. Since then, he has served as a section sergeant, platoon sergeant, drill sergeant, first sergeant, and food service sergeant major.

Campbell's assignments include: culinary specialist, first cook, senior food operations sergeant, squad leader, platoon sergeant in the 2nd Armored Division and 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood Texas; drill sergeant, senior drill sergeant and first sergeant in the 266th Quartermaster Battalion, 23rd Quartermaster Brigade, Fort Lee, Virginia; first sergeant, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 43rd Sustainment Brigade, Fort Carson, Colorado; and food service sergeant major, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Red Cloud, Korea.

Campbell has served in Bosnia (IFOR) as a QRF member; Operation Iraqi Freedom I as a platoon sergeant and Operation Enduring Freedom 10-11 as a first sergeant.

Campbell has attended numerous military schools and training programs to include: Drill Sergeant School; First Sergeants Course and the United States Sergeants Major Academy, Class 63.
