MEMORANDUM FOR All Army in Europe Military Personnel

SUBJECT: Authorization to Roll Up Sleeves on the Army Combat Uniform

This memorandum expires in 2 years.

1. References:

a. DA Pamphlet 670-1, Guide to the Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia.

b. Memorandum, Department of the Army, Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1, 28 June 2016, subject: Authorization to Roll Sleeves on the Army Combat Uniform (ACU) ([encl](#)).

2. In accordance with [reference 1b](#) and unless otherwise directed by a commander in their chain of command to keep ACU sleeves down, Army in Europe Soldiers may roll up the sleeves of their ACU whenever they like. This policy is subject to the requirements in paragraph 2 of [reference 1b](#) and the limitations prescribed in [paragraph 3](#) below.

3. In the Army in Europe, commanders in the grade of colonel are the approval authorities for the wear of the sleeves on the ACU during formations. During formations, sleeves will be displayed in a standardized manner (that is, all sleeves rolled down or all sleeves rolled up). These commanders may delegate this authority to subordinate commanders.

SUBJECT: Authorization to Roll Sleeves on the Army Combat Uniform (ACU)

1. Reference: Department of the Army pamphlet (DA Pam) 670-1, Guide to the Wear and Appearance of the Army Uniforms and Insignia, 1 July 2015.
2. Effective immediately, Commanders may authorize Soldiers to roll-up the sleeves on the universal camouflage pattern (UCP) ACU, operational camouflage pattern (OCP) ACU or operation enduring freedom camouflage pattern (OEF-CP) ACU. When Soldiers wear the sleeves of the ACU coat rolled up, the camouflage pattern will remain exposed. Personnel will roll sleeves neatly above the elbow but no more than 3 inches above the elbow. Upon approval of the commander and only during field training exercises, the sleeves may be down and cuffed inside the coat.
3. This authorization serves as an exception to DA Pam 670-1, paragraph 4-8d and is rescinded upon publication of any revision of DA Pam 670-1.
