Brig. Gen. Phillip S. Jolly's career spans over 32 years of military service representing active and reserve experience.

After graduating from the University of Mississippi in May 1983 with a Bachelor of Arts degree, he commissioned in the United States Army Ready Reserves as a second lieutenant, ordnance officer, and served ten years on active duty.

His early assignments included positions at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland; 3rd Corps Support Command, Wiesbaden and Baumholder, Germany; and 1st Corps Support Command, Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

Brig. Gen. Jolly has served in various staff positions to include Adjutant, 189th Maintenance Battalion; Chief, 1st COSCOM G4 Maintenance Division; Unit Training Officer in the Deputy Chief of Staff, G3, 87th Training Support Division; Chief, Readiness Team, Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff G4, and Deputy Chief of Staff G4, 81st Regional Readiness Command DCS, G4; Chief of Staff and Deputy Commander for the 926th Engineer Brigade.

He has commanded the 659th Maintenance Company, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; 361st Quartermaster Battalion, Montgomery, Alabama, and the 96th Sustainment Brigade, headquartered in Salt Lake City, Utah. In July 2011, he was selected to command the 364th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) and consecutively the Mission Support Element, headquartered in Marysville, Washington.

Prior to coming to U.S. Army Europe, he commanded the Army Reserve Sustainment Command headquartered in Birmingham, Alabama, from August 2012-July 2015.

Brig. Gen. Jolly has deployed in support of Operations Desert Shield, Desert Storm and Iraqi Freedom.
