SUBJECT: Priority Placement Program (PPP) Overseas Extensions

1. References:

- a. AR 690-300, Civilian Personnel Employment, Chapter 301, subchapter 5-3b, 15 Oct 87.
- b. Memorandum, HQ USAREUR/7A, AEAGA-C, 30 Jul 04, subject: Priority Placement Program (PPP) Overseas Extensions and Qualifications.
- c. DOD PPP Handbook, July 2011 with subsequent updates.

2. PURPOSE: To clarify whether tour extensions of any kind can be approved after accepting a DOD PPP job offer.

3. Reference a states that no type of tour extension will be granted after a PPP offer is accepted. The intent of the regulation is to prohibit the granting of tour extensions after an employee accepts a PPP job offer. However, the regulation does not prohibit an employee from seeking other employment in the overseas area prior to, and within agency timelines, for accepting a PPP job offer. If an employee is so selected by another overseas organization prior to accepting a PPP offer and the approving official at the new activity is willing to extend the employee's overseas tour, then the subsequent tour extension can be processed.

4. This memorandum rescinds and replaces reference b.
