Brig. Gen. Timothy J. Daugherty is a native of Alabama. He assumed duties as the United States Army Europe, Deputy Chief of Staff, G3 on May 15, 2016. Through the ROTC program he earned his commission as a second lieutenant in the United States Army Field Artillery Corps in August 1988, and is a graduate of Jacksonville State University where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice.

Upon completion of the Officer Basic Course, Daugherty was assigned to B Battery, 2d Battalion, 3d Field Artillery Regiment, United States Army Europe and Seventh Army in Heidelberg, Germany where he served as the Fire Support Officer.

Some of his key assignments include: Deputy Commanding General, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Carson, Colorado and Operation Atlantic Resolve, Germany, May 2015-May 2016; Executive Officer to the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-3/5/7, United States Army, Washington, D.C., July 2013-July 2015; and Commander, 214th Field Artillery Brigade, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Sill, Oklahoma and Operation Enduring Freedom, Afghanistan, June 2011-July 2013.
