## Deputy G6



Jack Gannon assumed the duties of the Deputy Director Operation Communications and Information Systems and Regional Chief Information Officer – Europe on March 16, 2008. He was formerly the Director, Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Information Support for Headquarters, U.S. Army Europe G6 where he had been assigned since July 10, 2001. As the Director of C4IS, Mr. Gannon was responsible for planning, coordinating and executing C4 services in support of U.S. Army Europe. His primary responsibilities included theater communications security support, spectrum supportability, exercise communications planning, tactical communications support to Operation OEF and OIF and project management.

Prior to his assignment with U.S. Army Europe, Gannon was a Product Manager and Senior Systems Engineer for Bell Communications Research in Piscataway, New Jersey. He was responsible for product development of a wireless field access system supporting Regional Bell Operating Companies in both the United States and South America.

Gannon served in the U.S. Army from 1980 to 2000 with various Signal Corps units in Germany and the continental United States.

A native of New York, New York, Gannon is a graduate of the City University of New York and also holds a Master of Business Administration Degree from the Florida Institute of Technology and a Master's Degree in Communication and Information Studies from Rutgers University in New Jersey.
