MEMORANDUM FOR All JMRC and Hohenfels Soldiers and Civilians

SUBJECT: Commander's Policy Letter #3e - Sexual Harrasment and Assault Response Program (SHARP)

1. References. Department of Defense Directive, 6495.01; Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Program, 6 Oct 05; Army Regulation (AR) 600-20, Chapter 8; Army Command Policy, 7 Jun 06; Manual for Courts-Martial (2008), Article 120.
2. Rape, sexual assault and sexual misconduct are crimes defined as intentional sexual contact, characterized by use of force, causing or threatening grievous bodily harm, rendering a person unconscious, abuse of authority, or when the victim does not or cannot consent. Article 120 of the UCMJ includes rape, aggravated sexual assault, aggravated sexual contact, abusive sexual contact, indecent acts, forcible pandering, wrongful sexual contact, indecent exposure, or attempts to commit these acts as violations.
3. This command has no tolerance for sexual assault. Sexual assault degrades our readiness by devastating our ability to work as a team. Sexual assault is incompatible with Army values and is punishable under UCMJ and other federal and local laws.
4. Victims of sexual assault have the right to be treated with dignity, respect, fairness, and have a reasonable expectation for privacy. Confidential victim services are available by contacting the Sexual Assault Hotline at 0162-296-1075.
5. Any Soldier or civilian who is aware of a sexual assault must immediately (within 24 hours) report the incident to the chain of command or the Military Police.
6. Restricted reports may be initiated through Unit Victim Advocates, the Hohenfels Sexual Assault Response Coordinator, chaplain, and/or health care providers.
7. Unrestricted reports will be thoroughly investigated by CID or Law Enforcement and offenders will be held accountable.
