Additional Notes

1. All Items on the above list MUST be IAW AR 670-1 and CTA 50 requirements, and proper fit.
 - i.e. serviceable, proper nametapes, (w/nametape Gortex Jacket and ACU's)
 - a. Part I of the Pre-Execution Checklist must reflect that the Soldier has all appropriate clothing and equipment. The 7th Army NCO Academy will only issue missing items under the following circumstances
 - b. Coordination is made with the CHOT prior to the student arrival at WLC.
 - c. The Soldier presents a memorandum listing the missing items and the reason why the unit could not obtain the items.

d. This inspection sheet is signed by the Soldier's sponsor. It is the responsibility of the unit to correct all equipment shortages within 72hrs of DAY 2 of WLC.

2. Personal Hygiene Kit (w/ articles), Due to climate conditions in Grafenwoehr during the summer months, it is recommended that Soldiers bring insect repellent and sunscreen.

3. NO FIRE RETARDANT ACU (FRACU/ACU2).

4. The tan combat boot may only be worn with the ACU uniform. Tan, all leather issue, or the RFI leather w/ thickened fabric (desert). Boots must be IAW AR 670-1. Hi-Tech boots are not authorized.

5. BLACK GLOVES ARE THE ONLY GLOVES AUTHORIZED FOR PT.

a. Students may also bring Nomex gloves, or other tactical gloves as long as it was part of a RFI or CIF issue.*

6. CIVILIAN ATTIRE MUST BE CASUAL WEAR AND APPROPRIATE, NO "INAPPROPRIATE" CLOTHING

7. CIF equipment:

a. The Load Bearing Vest is the standard but the Load Bearing Equipment or Modular Lightweight Load Carrying Equipment (MOLLE) gear can be used if not issued. The Belt Individual Equipment is needed when using the LBE or LBV,

Soldier must have two ammo pouches, canteens, and Improved first aid kit (IFAK). If the equipment is mounted on the IBAS gear Soldier does not need LBV/LBE or MOLLE vest

b. IBA/IOTV Complete is with throat and groin protection w/ "SAPI" plates

c. Bring frame, all straps and belts required for use with the rucksack (ALICE/MOLLE pack)

d. Soldiers will bring Canteen and camelback (RFI issue only).

8. Winter packing list will consists of the ECWS items (31 Aug-1 May)

a. ECWS Undershirt and Drawers consist of: Light Weight Undershirt and Drawers (aka silk weights/ninja suit) Black or Tan, Mid-Weight Shirt and Drawers (waffle top and bottom) Or Polypro top and bottom for the base layer, the Light or Mid Weight layers will suffice, Soldiers do not need to have both layers.

Additional Information

1. ATM Machine is currently available

2. Personal music electronic items (i.e. IPOD's, MP3 players etc.) are authorized for use with headphones only on personal time.

3. Computer access is limited. You must have Common Access Card (CAC) availability on the EUR domain to use the Academy Computers.

4. You are authorized to bring more items than what is required on the packing list!!!!

5. Breakfast is not provided on day 1, sponsors/schools NCO's are responsible for their Soldiers eating prior to arrival

If you are on prescription medications, carry enough to last you the 18-day cycle. This is to include allergy medications and bee sting kits.
