PRINT, BROADCAST JOURNALISTS ACROSS EUROPE EARN HONORS IN ANNUAL ARMY COMPETITION

Several Army journalists in Europe earned awards in the Department of the Army level of the 2007 Maj. Gen. Keith L. Ware Journalism Awards competition.

The award, named for a World War II Medal of Honor recipient and former Army Chief of Information who was killed in action in Vietnam, recognizes excellence in Army print and broadcast journalism.

Journalists across Europe earned 41 awards, including a first-place win for U.S. Army Garrison Grafenwoehr's Bavarian News in the tabloid publication category, and a second-place win for U.S. Army Europe's EURArmy magazine in the magazine publication category.
