## 21st Theater Sustainment Command Kaiserslautern, Germany

The 21st Theater Sustainment Command is the United States Army in Europe's senior sustainment formation, supporting three U.S. Geographic Combatant Commands (EUCOM, AFRICOM & CENTCOM).

As a theater sustainment command, the 21st TSC is the senior Army sustainment organization in theater--geographically focused, but globally employable. Providing a centralized logistics mission command structure for the theater Army HQ, they manage materiel for all Army forces assigned or deployed within our area of operations for joint and national as well as multinational events simultaneously supporting deployment, movement, sustainment, redeployment, reconstitution, and retrograde. They also provide robust Financial Management Center and Human Resources Center functions.

The 21st TSC provides unique capabilities:

- Theater Security Cooperation and Building Partnership Capacity through direct support to multinational training events in the European Theater, supporting 27 Operations and Exercises throughout 25 Countries in 2010.
- Capacity to simultaneously support three COCOMs. Typical weekly support includes:
  - **Maintain**
    - 681 items inducted into the Left Behind Equipment program
    - 15,000 items maintained (\$1.9B value)
  - **Arm**
    - Receive/issue 22 short tons to 11 USAREUR units
    - Move 74 short tons throughout theater
    - \$35M inventory
  - **Supply / Equip**
    - Return 784 pieces of excess to record
    - Store 19K lines valued over \$56M
    - Process 32K requisitions
    - Issue 18K items
  - **Deploy**
    - One battalion's worth of personnel and equipment to accompany troops
  - **Move**
    - 1500+ ground missions
    - 23,000 miles (9X coast-to-coast)
    - 585 short tons of mail
  - **Financial Management**
    - Disburse \$23M
  - **Community Law Enforcement**
    - 1610 postings across 19 installations
  - **Personnel**
    - Process 286 Soldiers, 162 Family members through Gateways
- Mission control over multiple brigade-level and higher subordinate units, including the unique 7th Civil Support Command and the Theater Logistics Support Center-Europe.
- Specialized consequence management capabilities via the 7th CSC, including chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear assessment and assistance, robust Civil Affairs capabilities, and the only Public Affairs Detachment in theater.
