## Joint Multinational Training Command

The 7th U.S. Army Joint Multinational Training Command (JMTC) is the Army's largest training command outside of the continental United States. The JMTC provides training of U.S. and multinational forces to dominate full-spectrum operations to support the U.S. Army in Europe's global requirements and U.S. European Command's Strategy of Active Security. The JMTC provides military forces the training and training support required to accomplish today's missions and succeed in future contingencies. Our adaptive live, virtual, constructive and gaming capabilities deliver unique training solutions that allow Commanders to generate cohesive, trained forces capable of dominating in any operational environment.

- The professional opposing force, observers, controllers and trainers at the Hohenfels Training Area (HTA) provide challenging and current maneuver-combat training from the individual to the brigade-staff level.
- The simulations center offers state-of-the-art virtual, constructive and gaming training support to units throughout Europe.
- The Grafenwöhr Training Area has 44 modern, computerized live-fire ranges, including the Army's only 360-degree, live-fire combat outpost training facility.
- Training Support Activity Europe provides home-station training support, while also sustaining biologically-rich training areas that support more than three-thousand different animal and plant species, of those, almost 800 hundred are threatened or endangered.
- The 7th U.S. Army Noncommissioned Officers Academy (7th Army NCOA) is the Army's oldest and largest academy and has developed junior leaders in Europe for more than 60 years.
- The Combined Arms Training Center (CATC) provides advanced functional training which, builds basic Soldier tactical-and-technical competence at the individual level.

The JMTC provides a state-of-the-art training platform for our multinational partners and allies to build and sustain their operational capacity. Our training capabilities and proximity to European, Asian and African partners makes us the unrivaled choice to support Security Force Assistance programs and initiatives.

- More than 86 percent of the coalition forces currently deployed to Afghanistan are provided by European allies and partners.
- More than 5,000 multinational Soldiers have completed Operational Mentor and Liaison Team (OMLT) training at HTA, since 2009.
- JMTC has provided Counter-Improvised Explosive Device (CIED) training to more than 5,000 multinational Soldiers, since 2010.
- Nearly 600 International Military Students from 27 countries have completed the Warrior Leader Course at the 7th Army NCOA, since 2003.
- In 2010 alone, the JMTC's simulations center has conducted eight major Theater Engagement Exercises and 55 significant events with more than 10,000 multinational participants.
- Nearly 4,000 multinational Soldiers have completed specialized functional training at CATC, since 2003.

As the 'crown jewel' of U.S. Army in Europe, the JMTC continues to help U.S. and multinational forces prevail in the current fight, while preparing Soldiers and leaders to defeat future threats.
